Daily Quote from the Early Church Fathers: Healing of soul and body, by Hilary of Poitiers (315-367 AD)
"Now in the narrative of the paralytic a number of people are brought forward for healing. Jesus' words of healing are worthy of reflection. The paralytic is not told, 'Be healed.' He is not told, 'Rise and walk.' But he is told, 'Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven you.' The paralytic is a descendant of the original man, Adam. In one person, Christ, all the sins of Adam are forgiven. In this case the person to be healed is brought forward by ministering angels. In this case, too, he is called a son, because he is God's first work. The sins of his soul are forgiven him, and pardon of the first transgression is granted. We do not believe the paralytic committed any sin [that resulted in his illness], especially since the Lord said elsewhere that blindness from birth had not been contracted from someone's sin or that of his parents" [John 9:1-3]. “I am sure that many of you have discovered in your work for the poor that, while their material needs are often great, their spiritual needs may be greater still. I am sure, too, that many of you have discovered that on many occasions, when the poor present a problem to you or seek your advice, you come eventually to realize that their real need is not your advice, but rather the sympathy of your listening heart. Often I feel that I have given advice to people when what they were really asking for was understanding and compassion. Registration for Catechism

We are still accepting registrations for 1st year of First Communion only. Registration forms will be made available in the Parish Office, online and in the vestibule of St. Anthony and St. Martin churches. When completing the registration form, be sure to complete both sides of the form. Registration forms are to be submitted to the Parish Office with a copy of the child’s birth certificate and baptism certificate. The registration fee for first year First Communion is \$80. Forms of payment accepted are cash, check or money order. We do not accept electronic forms of payment. Hours for registering will be Monday – Thursday 9am-5pm at St. Anthony Parish Office. Additional registration times will be announced as the date gets closer. The last day of registration will be in July. We will not accept late registrations.

Currently all 1st year Confirmation classes are full. If we are able to open additional classes, we will announce that in the bulletin and announcements.

Classes will begin on Sunday, September 21, 2025, at St. Anthony and on Monday, September 22, 2025, at St. Martin.

Inscripción para Catecismo

Seguimos aceptando inscripciones solo para el primer año de Primera Comunión. Los formularios de inscripción estarán disponibles en la Oficina Parroquial, en línea y en el vestíbulo de las iglesias de San Antonio y San Martín. Al completar el formulario de inscripción, asegúrese de llenar ambos lados. Los formularios de inscripción deben entregarse en la Oficina Parroquial junto con una copia del acta de nacimiento y del acta de bautismo del niño. La cuota de inscripción para el primer año de Primera Comunión es de \$80. Se aceptan pagos en efectivo, cheque o giro postal. No aceptamos pagos electrónicos. El horario de inscripción será de lunes a jueves de 9:00 a. m. a 5:00 p. m. en la Oficina Parroquial de San Antonio. Se anunciarán horarios adicionales de inscripción a medida que se acerque la fecha. El último día de inscripción será en julio. No se aceptarán inscripciones tardías.

Actualmente, todas las clases de Confirmación de primer año están llenas. Si logramos abrir más clases, lo anunciaremos en el boletín y los anuncios.

Las clases comenzarán el domingo 21 de septiembre de 2025 en St. Anthony y el lunes 22 de septiembre de 2025 en St. Martin.
