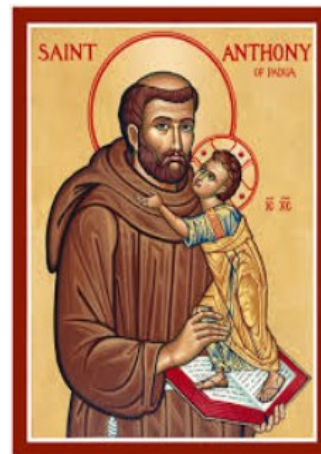

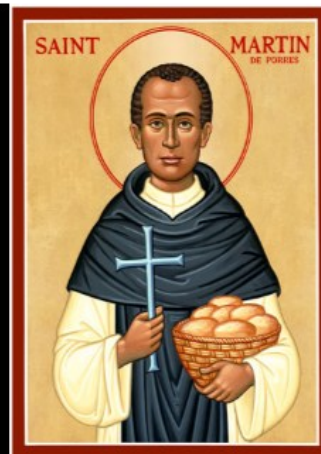

The Treasures of our Church –
Fasting and Abstaining, Praying, and Giving Alms

This season of Lent, we practice penance through fasting/abstaining, praying and giving alms. These are ways on which we renew our relationship with God.

ABSTINENCE. All persons, 14 years and older, are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. Other forms of abstinence, for example abstinence from alcoholic beverages, television, video games, the internet, and social media, are also beneficial.

FASTING. Everyone from ages 18 to 59 is obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Voluntary fasting on other weekdays of Lent, especially on Wednesdays and Fridays, is highly recommended. Fasting is understood to mean that one full meal may be eaten in a day. Two other small meals may be eaten, but together they should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted.

When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, neither the law of fasting nor the law of abstinence obliges. If in doubt, one's parish priest or confessor should be consulted.

PRAYING. Catholics are urged to read and pray with sacred Scripture more intently during Lent, and to deepen their faith by reading the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The faithful are encouraged to participate in special devotions offered by the parish, especially parish penance services and Eucharistic adoration. Other devotions such as the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, visits to the Blessed Sacrament, and praying for vocations to the priesthood and religious life are also encouraged.

Patience is another one of those things many of us struggle with. We want things to go according to our plan and our schedule. Any change brings anxiety and fear. Through daily prayer we better align ourselves with God's will and His plan, which is far better than anything we can come up with on our own. (Archdiocese of St. Louis Stewardship Office)

Los Tesoros de nuestra Iglesia –
El Ayuno y la Abstención, la Oración y la Limosna

Esta temporada de Cuaresma, practicamos la penitencia a través del ayuno/abstención, la oración y la limosna. Estas son formas en las que renovamos nuestra relación con Dios.

ABSTINENCIA. Todas las personas mayores de 14 años están obligadas a abstenerse de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza y todos los viernes de Cuaresma. Otras formas de abstinencia, por ejemplo, abstinencia de bebidas alcohólicas, televisión, videojuegos, Internet, y las redes sociales, también son beneficiosos.

AYUNO. Todas las personas de 18 a 59 años están obligadas a ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Se recomienda encarecidamente el ayuno voluntario en otros días de la semana de Cuaresma, especialmente los miércoles y viernes. Se entiende que el ayuno significa que se puede comer una comida completa al día. Se pueden comer otras dos comidas pequeñas, pero juntas no deben equivaler a una comida completa. No se permite comer entre-comidas.

Quando la salud o la capacidad para trabajar se verían gravemente afectadas, ni la ley del ayuno ni la ley de la abstinencia obligan. En caso de duda, se debe consultar al párroco o al confesor.

ORANDO. Se insta a los católicos a leer y orar con la Sagrada Escritura con más atención durante la Cuaresma y a profundizar su fe leyendo el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica. Se anima a los fieles a participar en las devociones especiales que ofrece la parroquia, especialmente los servicios de penitencia parroquial y la adoración eucarística. También se fomentan otras devociones como el Rosario, la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia, las visitas al Santísimo Sacramento y la oración por las vocaciones al sacerdocio ya la vida religiosa.
