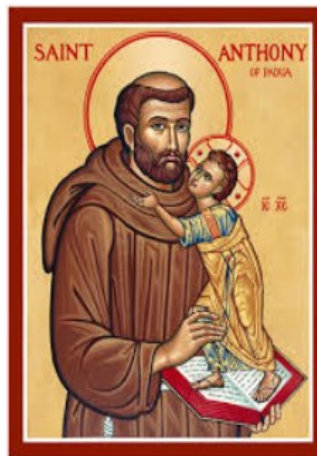

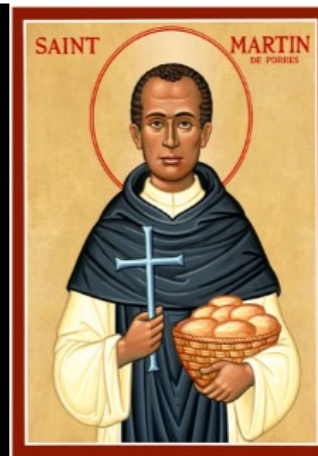

OBLIGATORY FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

April 3 Will be Good Friday. It will be a day of obligatory fasting and abstinence.

ABSTINENCE. Is for all persons, 14 years and older, do not eat meat this day.

FASTING. Everyone from ages 18 to 59 is obliged to fast on Good Friday. Fasting is understood to mean that one full meal may be eaten in a day. Two other small meals may be eaten, but together they should not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted.

AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA OBLIGATORIOS
El 3 de abril será Viernes Santo. Será un día de ayuno y abstinencia obligatorios.

ABSTINENCIA. Todas las personas mayores de 14 años están obligadas a abstenerse de comer carne este día.

AYUNO. Todas las personas de 18 a 59 años están obligadas a ayunar el Viernes Santo. Se entiende que el ayuno significa que se puede comer una comida completa al día. Se pueden comer otras dos comidas pequeñas, pero juntas no deben equivaler a una comida completa. No se permite comer entre-comidas.
