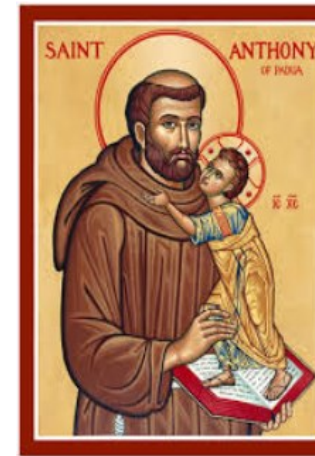

Interested in placing an ad in our bulletin? You can do this for only \$50/month...

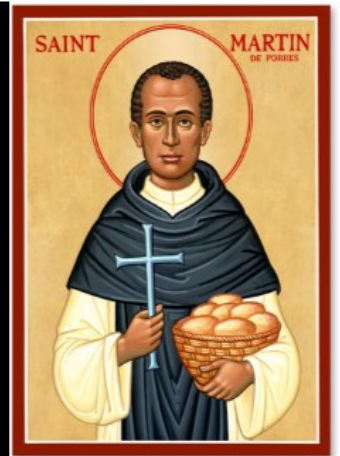
