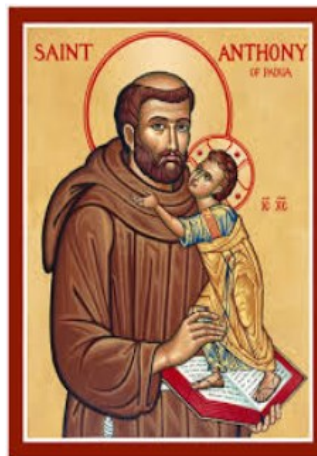

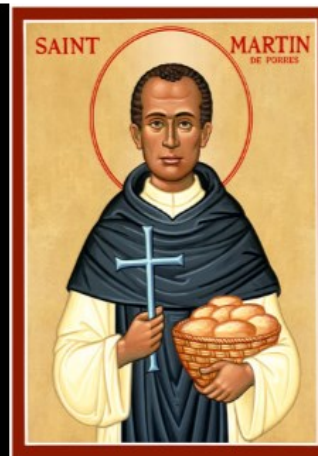
Interested in placing an ad in our bulletin? You can do this for only \$50/month...

Daily Quote from the Early Church Fathers: The strong man bound, by Irenaeus, 135-202 A.D.

“The adversary enticed humanity to transgress our maker's law, and thereby got us into his clutches (Genesis 3:1-6). Yet his power consisted only in tempting the human will toward trespass and apostasy. With these chains he bound up the human will. This is why in the economy of salvation it was necessary that he be bound with the same chains by which he had bound humanity. It would be through a man that humanity would be set free to return to the Lord (Romans 5:18), leaving the adversary in those bonds by which he himself had been fettered, that is, sin. For when Satan is bound, man is set free; since 'none can enter a strong man's house and spoil his goods, unless he first bind the strong man himself' (Matthew 12:29; Mark 3:27). It is in this way that he became exposed as the opposer of the Word who made all things, and subdued by his command. The new man showed him to be a fugitive from the law, and an apostate from God. He then was securely bound as a fugitive, and his goods hauled away. These goods are those who had been in bondage, whom he had unjustly used for his own purposes. So it was a just means by which he was led captive, who had led humanity into captivity unjustly. In this way humanity was rescued from the clutches of its possessor by the tender mercy of God the Father, who had compassion on his own handiwork, and gave to it salvation, restoring it by means of the Word, Christ, in order that humanity might learn from this actual event that they receive incorruptibility not of themselves, but by the free gift of God" (Romans 5:16). Registration for Catechism

Registration for catechism has begun.

Registration forms are available in the Parish Office, online or in the vestibule of St. Anthony and St. Martin churches. When completing the registration form, be sure to complete both sides of the form. Registration forms are to be submitted to the Parish Office with a copy of the child's baptism certificate. When registering for Confirmation, a copy of the First Communion certificate is also required. The registration fee for first year First Communion, second year First Communion and first year Confirmation is \$80. The registration fee for second year Confirmation is \$175. Forms of payment accepted are cash, check or money order. We do not accept electronic forms of payment. Hours for registering are Monday - Thursday 9am-5pm at St. Anthony Parish Office. Additional registration times will be Monday, June 10th and Thursday, June 13th 6pm-7pm at St. Anthony Parish Hall and Tuesday, June 18th 6pm - 7pm and Thursday, June 20th 5pm-6pm at St. Martin Mission. Classes fill up quickly so please register as soon as possible. The last day of registration will be in July. We will not accept late registrations.

Inscripción para el Catecismo

Las inscripciones para el catecismo han comenzado. Las formas de inscripción están disponibles en la Oficina Parroquial, en línea o en el vestíbulo de las iglesias de San Antonio y San Martín. Al completar la forma de registro, asegúrese de completar ambos lados de la forma. Las formas de inscripción deben presentarse en la Oficina Parroquial con una copia del certificado de bautismo del niño. Al registrarse para la Confirmación, también se requiere una copia del certificado de Primera Comunión. La tarifa de inscripción para el primer año de Primera Comunión, el segundo año de Primera Comunión y el primer año de Confirmación es de \$80. La tarifa de inscripción para la Confirmación del segundo año es de \$175. Las formas de pago aceptadas son efectivo, cheque o money order. No aceptamos formas electrónicas de pago. El horario de inscripción es de lunes a jueves de 9am a 5pm en la oficina parroquial de San Antonio. Los horarios de inscripción adicionales serán el lunes 10 de junio y el jueves 13 de junio de 6pm a 7pm en el Salón Parroquial de San Antonio y el martes 1 de junio de 6pm a 7pm y el jueves 20 de junio de 5pm a 6pm. en la Misión de San Martín. Las clases se llenan rápidamente, así que regístrese lo antes posible. El último día de inscripción será en julio. No aceptaremos inscripciones tardías.
