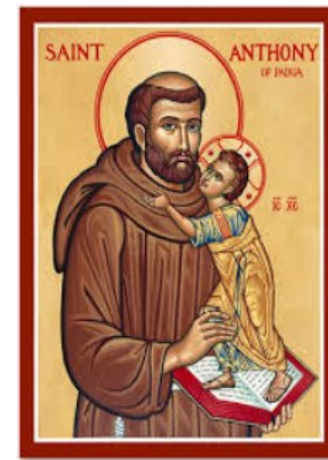

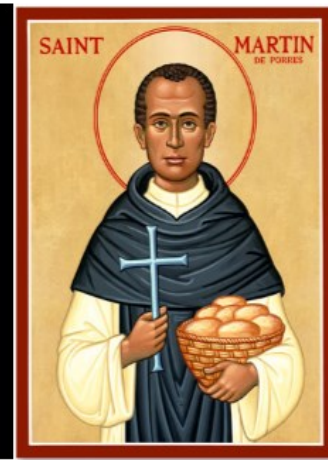

**Registration for Catechism**

Registration forms are available in the Parish Office, online or in the vestibule of St. Anthony and St. Martin churches. When completing the registration form, be sure to complete both sides of the form. Registration forms are to be submitted to the Parish Office with a copy of the child’s baptism certificate. When registering for Confirmation, a copy of the First Communion certificate is also required. The registration fee for first year First Communion, second year First Communion and first year Confirmation is \$80. The registration fee for second year Confirmation is \$175. Forms of payment accepted are cash, check or money order. We do not accept electronic forms of payment. Hours for registering are Monday – Thursday 9am-5pm at St. Anthony Parish Office. Classes fill up quickly so please register as soon as possible. The last day of registration will be in July. We will not accept late registrations.
