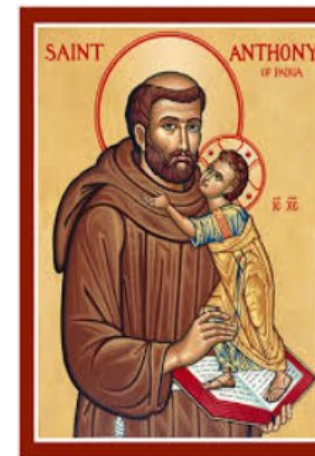
Bulletin Ads

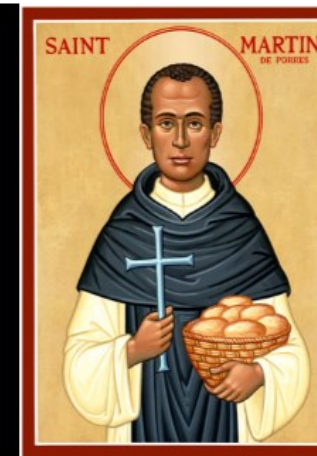

St. Vincent de Paul Esparto Update

It has been a year of high rent and utility bills making themselves known. While PG&E offers a utility forgiveness plan many in our community have difficulty meeting and/or following through on the requirements. In many of these cases utilities were turned off and not re-energized until payment was made. Our conference was able to provide aid both financially and with our time, in helping our neighbors navigate through the process. And indeed, rent continues to challenge many in our community as soon as unforeseen expenses crop up. These ranged from sudden medical care to transportation challenges. We are happy to do the best we can in supporting our local community with the funds collected on 5th Sundays and during fundraising breakfasts. Since January we have helped 41 neighbors, including children in the home, by covering services in the amount of \$5,797 dollars. During the last 5th Sunday almost \$1,000 was donated, our largest collection this year! Thank you for your support and please consider joining the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.

Actualización de St. Vincent de Paul Esparto

Ha sido un año en el que las altas facturas de alquiler y servicios públicos se han hecho notar. Si bien PG&E ofrece un plan de condonación de servicios públicos, muchos en nuestra comunidad tienen dificultades para cumplir y/o seguir los requisitos. En muchos de estos casos, los servicios públicos se desconectaron y no se volvieron a activar hasta que se realizó el pago. Nuestra conferencia pudo brindar ayuda tanto financiera como con nuestro tiempo, para ayudar a nuestros vecinos a navegar por el proceso. Y, de hecho, el alquiler continúa desafiando a muchos en nuestra comunidad tan pronto como surgen gastos imprevistos. Estos van desde atención médica repentina hasta desafíos de transporte. Estamos felices de hacer lo mejor que podemos para apoyar a nuestra comunidad local con los fondos recaudados el quinto domingo y durante los desayunos de recaudación de fondos. Desde enero, hemos ayudado a 41 vecinos, incluidos los niños en el hogar, cubriendo servicios por un monto de \$ 5,797 dólares. Durante el último quinto domingo se donaron casi \$1,000, ¡nuestra colecta más grande este año! Gracias por su apoyo y considere unirse a la Sociedad de San Vicente de Paul.
